#### **ABOUT ABMS**

ISO 37001 Anti-Bribery Management Systems addresses one of the world's most destructive and challenging issues head-on, and demonstrates an organisation's committed approach to stamping out corruption.

ISO 37001 institutes measures to prevent, detect and address bribery through adopting an anti-bribery policy, appointing personnel to oversee anti-bribery compliance, which complement efforts such as training, risk assessments and due diligence on projects and business associates, implementing financial and commercial controls, as well as instituting reporting and investigation procedures, all of which comply with local and international antibribery laws.

ISO 37001 can be used by any organisation, large or small, be it in the public, private or voluntary sector, and in any country. It is a flexible tool, which can be adapted according to the size and nature of the organisation and the bribery risks it faces.
